Are Coggno courses Apple/Mac and PC friendly?

Courses are delivered through a Learning Management System (LMS) online and can be viewed on multiple platforms and mobile devices, including PC, Mac, and iPads.

What type of Internet connection and browser that are recommended?

Coggno recommends a high-speed Internet connection (T1, Broadband, or DSL) for all content being delivered via our Learning Management System (LMS). We highly recommend at least 4Mbps and higher Mbps connection speed to accommodate all features we offer via Coggno.
